How is the course assessed?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Listening, Reading & Writing tests must be completed in the same day • Speaking skills test may be taken 7 days prior to the modules above

Any deadlines I should know about?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • None. There are 48 fixed tests each year • At least 2 tests each month (academic tests)
